I. Committee Matrix

Bob opened the meeting by explaining the committee matrix that he and Holly had put together. Bob asked that everyone look at the matrix and decide which category each fits under. (see chart below)

II. 5010 GOALS

Discussion was held regarding the 5010 and its goals. Bob put together a draft paper that he will send out for everyone to update and work from.

1. TRANSITION:

- a. Go – No Go Decision no later than January 1, 2011;
 - 1)** 5010 Code Set frozen, based on:
 - a)** 100% agreement by key stakeholders on the 5010 standards;
 - b)** 180 day countdown from July 1, 2010;
 - 2)** All extensions of January 1, 2011 date will add and identical extension to the January 1, 2012 date.
- b. Permissive/optional implementation beginning January 1, 2011;
- c. NO extensions unless they are universal;

2. TESTING:

- a. Testing protocols should provide for:

- 1) Iterative testing with test and/or live data;
- 2) "No-fault" testing through September 30, 2011;
- 3) Mandatory testing availability no later than July 1, 2011;

3. **LIVE DATE PREREQUISITES:**

- a. Universal readiness (> 90% of claim volume processors);
 - 1) Including:
 - a) Medicare (all products, including Part C, Part D, Railroad, SSI, etc.);
 - b) Medicare secondary plans, including cross-over claims;
 - c) Medicaid (all states);
 - d) Tricare;
 - e) Commercial insurers;
 - f) Blue Cross/Blue Shield plans;
 - g) Clearinghouses;
 - h) Others:
 - i. Workers' Compensation
 - ii. Auto insurers
- b. Remediation plans, including penalties, defined;

4. **COMPANION GUIDES:**

- a. NO Companion Guides; OR
- b. No more than five STANDARDIZED Companion Guides (e.g. Version A, Version B, etc);
- c. All Companion Guides, if any, must be published by March 31, 2011 or they are barred;
- d. FROZEN: NO changes for twelve months following 5010 live date;
