Minutes:

1. Holly reported HBMA submitted information on industry readiness in response to the CMS RFI and Holly, Bob Burleigh and Bill Finerfrock testified before NCVHS. Also, the group had a number of visits with Congressional staff and a Senator to discuss ICD-10/5010 implementation issues.
2. Coding-Melody reported that AHIMA is moving forward with great speed and that she will be developing a "roll out" schedule for billing company education and informational resources shortly.
3. 5010 testing & ICD-10 crosswalks-Doug reported that the Cooperative Exchange will be establishing a cumulative report of clearinghouses 5010 testing schedules that will be available on their website. They will also provide information on ICD-10 crosswalk testing once this is available. Chet clarified that reported "readiness to test" is specific to 837 only. Doug also reported:
  - The Cooperative Exchange has been speaking with key government officials on the idea of X-12 standards as the vehicle of sharing personal health information among providers.
  - That end to end testing for clearinghouses may be quite difficult
  - This all may require a total re-enrollment of providers
4. WPS-Jerry reported they are working with WPS testing of the 5010 standards
5. Meaningful use-Bob reviewed the 25 meaningful use objectives for physicians set forth by CMS.
6. We would like to determine if other key associations would like to collaborate with HBMA on the development of comments to CMS regarding the meaningful use standards. In addition, HBMA will prepare responses.:
