



Committee Term Limit Policy & Procedure

The Healthcare Business Management Association (HBMA) relies heavily on the activities of its various committees. To encourage volunteer opportunities and engagement in committee leadership, HBMA will require that all committee leaders (identified as “Chairs” and “Vice Chairs”) serve a maximum of a two-year term in their leadership position. Leadership may run for two consecutive terms, then must cycle out of the position for a minimum of one term (two years). A Vice Chair who has served one or two terms may transition to Chair and will be allowed to serve two terms as outlined above.

Committees may choose to have shorter term limits, and must have the term limits detailed in the committee charter. Committees are not permitted to create term limits that exceed two years.
