Certification Committee

- Initiatives Accomplished in 2023
 - Began a redesign of the CHBME program to ensure quality and up to date information that reflects the newest changes in the RCM industry
 - Began a redesign of the CHBME study guide
 - Began a redesign of the CHBME exam
- Current Projects
 - Complete the redesign of the CHBME program, study guide, and exam
 - Once redesign is completed, create a grandfathering program for existing CHBME holders to update to current information



Commercial Payor Relations Committee

- Initiatives Accomplished in 2023
 - Accomplished all set meetings, webinars, and payer panels with all participating health plan partners, Aetna, Cigna, and UHC
 - Partnered with Aetna to create a workgroup focused entirely on administrative simplification and received a resource guide exclusively for our members (can be found under the Resources tab of the website)
 - Continually worked with representatives from Aetna, Cigna, and United Healthcare to address items brought forward by HBMA members
- Current Projects
 - Continuing to work on administrative simplification with the payors HBMA has partnered with



Compliance & Ethics Committee

- Initiatives Accomplished in 2023
 - Started an in depth review of HBMA's compliance course to identify opportunities for improvement
 - Began a redesign of HBMA's compliance education to a virtual format
- Current Projects
 - Complete the redesign of the virtual compliance course and education



Data Science Committee

- Initiatives Accomplished in 2023
 - Launched four mini surveys to the membership: Accounts Receivable 1, Accounts Receivable 2, Staffing Ratios, and Denials.
 - Published results from first three surveys in the January issue of the RCM Advisor
- Current Projects
 - Continue to produce surveys surrounding issues that are important to HBMA members
 - Publish survey results in the RCM Advisor periodically



Education Committee

- Initiatives Accomplished in 2023
 - Updated the list of topics that are used to identify potential speakers for webinars and in person meetings
 - Organized HBMA's 2023 Fall Conference
 - Organized over 20 educational webinars over 2023
- Current Projects
 - Organizing and planning the 2024 Fall Conference
 - Reviewing abstract submissions for webinars with the goal of 20 webinars minimum in 2024

 - Continuing modifications to budgeting and financial oversight to ensure maximum effect

Government Relations Committee

• Initiatives Accomplished in 2023

- Hosted in-person CMS/Hill Day, which featured meetings with six CMS offices and eight Congressional offices and Committees.
- Served as a resource to several Congressional Committees and Offices to provide the RCM industry's perspective on proposed legislation regarding the life cycle of a healthcare claim, changes to hospital billing practices, and ideas to reform how Medicare makes changes to the Physician Fee Schedule.
- Supported legislation that would provide annual inflationary updates to the Medicare Physician Fee Schedule.

Current Projects

- Continuing to support legislation that mitigates recent Medicare payment reductions and long-term sustainable reforms to how Medicare adjusts payments to physicians.
- Increasing our legislative advocacy on Medicare Advantage. Supporting legislation that extends Medicare telehealth coverage flexibilities beyond 2024.
